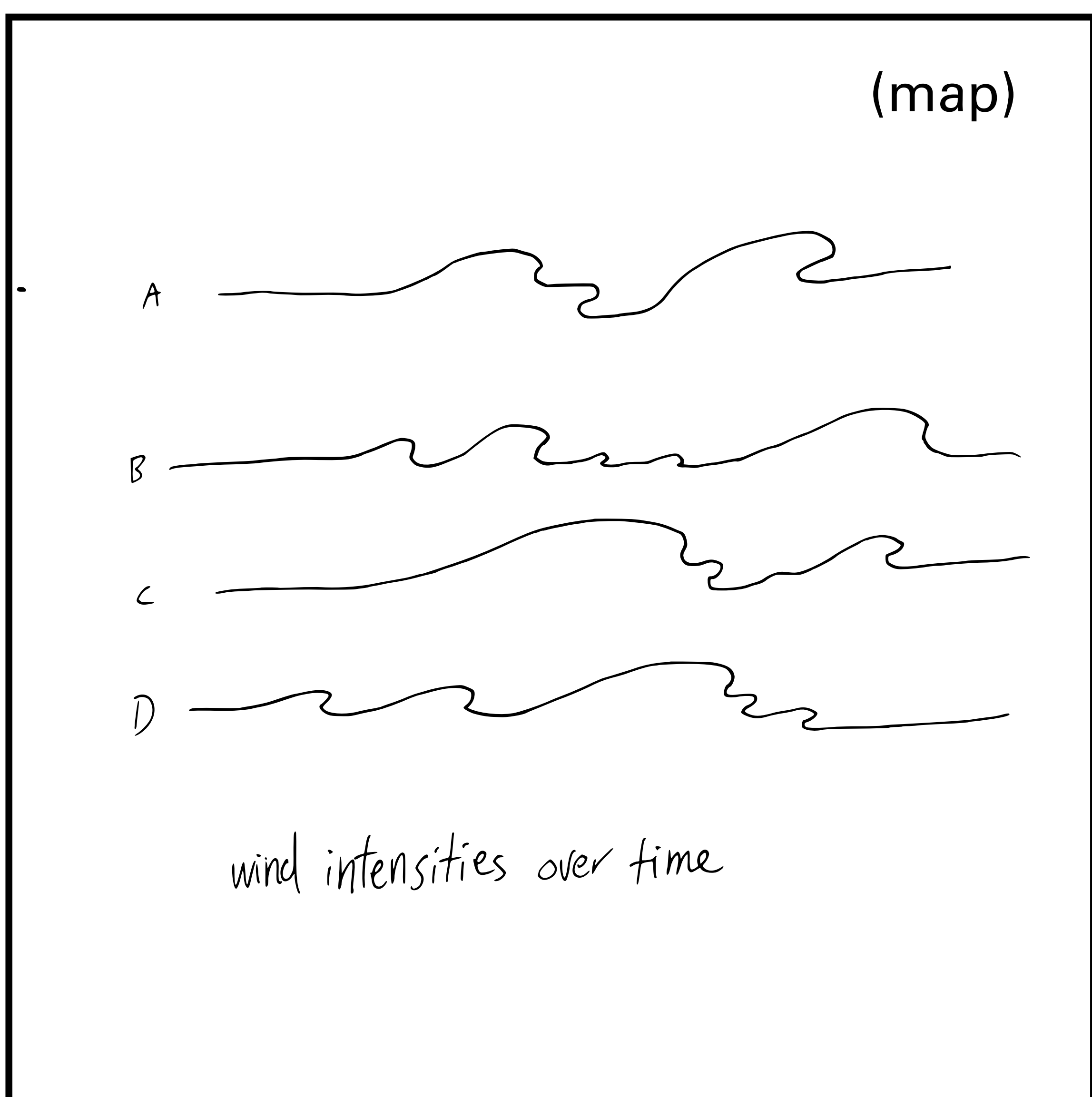


wind

a cluster of tones making up  
the fundamental voice :  
modal harmonic motion,  
vertically moving lines

example cluster: Ab Bb C  
low extensions: G F Eb C  
high extensions D Eb F G Ab  
Bb C

(focus)
